This month Michele is sharing some news from one of her many periodicals.

- The Los Angeles County Museum of Art is presenting, "Beyond Bling: Jewelry from the Lois Boardman Collection" through Feburary 5, 2017. One of the pieces featured in the announcement is Joyce Scott's PARTY necklace.
- Although NOT the necklace that's featured in the magazine, a sample of her work is shown to the right. If you are not familiar with Joyce Scott's amazing beadwork, check her out in Craft In America for more!
- Joyce has another piece, called Yazidi Sex Slave, featured in "Politically Speaking," an article about contemporary jewelry and how it is influenced by American politics.
- The first bead museum in China opened in Beijing in
 2015. Founded by Walker Qin, who has visited about one hundred bead museums in more than sixty countries, it has about four thousand beads, a reference library, and supports on-going bead research.
- In its fortieth year, the Philadelphia Museum of Art Craft Show 2016 features 50
 new artists. "The biggest surprise has been how the younger, tech-savvy
 generation continues to embrace the relevance and importance of handmade
 work," says a Committee member. An example is glass artist Robert Coby's series
 called Topography.



• There's an exhibit called Heavenly Bodies: The Sun, Moon and Stars in Jewellery in Pforzheim's Jewelry Museum. As an aerospace/aeronautical (depending on which degree you look at) and a child of the 60's, I've always been interested in space, the final frontier. The Ancient Greek word for cosmos means universe, order and jewelry. Humans have looked to the heavens for millennia to find inspiration for gods, weather, designs, etc. Here's one of my favorite images from the article. It's called The Rising Sun Aigrette by Joseph Chaumet.

 The Denver Art Museum is hosting "Glitterati: Portraits and Jewelry from Colonial Latin America." Pearls were a huge source of wealth and inspiration, along with native emeralds, gold and silver. There's a circa 1690 Tiara of gilt silver, emeralds, and pearls on display that's very pretty.



 When my husband was in dental school he set up a casting laboratory in our house. So it was with humility and amazement that I read about David Freda's process for creating realistic flora and fauna. There are several pictures of pieces in work that is absolutely amazing.
