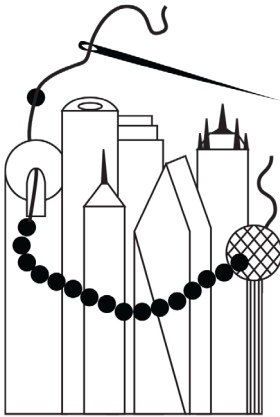

March Project

Janice Lynn will teach a bracelet project using CRAW (in red) that transitions to circular herringbone (in silver). Janice is teaching the bracelet with large beads so it is easier for those new to the stitches to learn them. You may also use smaller beads if you choose.

Supply List

- Red size 6° seed beads
- Silver size 8° seed beads
- Silver size 11° seed beads
- Fireline, 8 or 10 lb.

Diane describes the **Radiance** necklace as “sparkley, and shiny! And has been designed using unique radiance disks. You will build a custom bezel for the radiance disks in two different sizes, then embellish with Czech glass, and then connect together with shaped half-circles of zipped

Right Angle Weave (or work a CRAW version). This piece fits like a dream, and can be customized by using different sized toggle closures.” This project is for the advance beader.

Puttin' on the Ritz is a fashionable necklace and bracelet using herringbone/Ndebelle worked in a circular, tubular fashion. The necklace is an intermediate to advanced level and the bracelet is an intermediate beading level.

Saturday's class, March 25, is **Puttin' on the Ritz** and Sunday's class, March 26, is **Radiance** necklace.

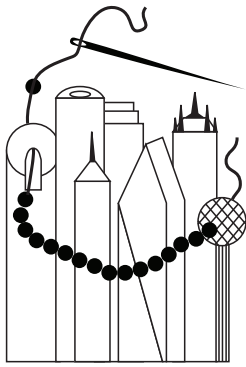

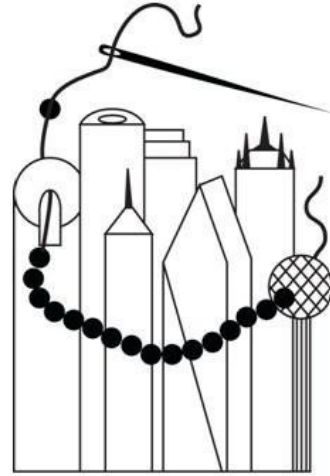
