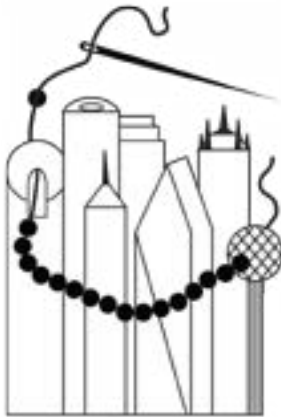

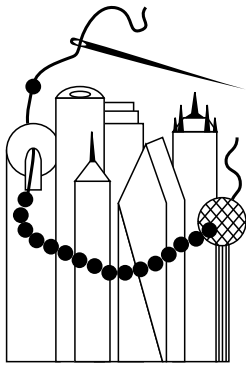
Laura suggested using my thread burner. It works well!
