Beaded Coin Challenge

Wow, it's really hard to believe that our last in person meeting was on March 2nd and here it is already August! Hopefully y'all are staying well, wearing your masks and washing your hands. So just to help you keep on beading we have a new challenge for you and it's called the Bead Coin Challenge. Thanks to Susan Byrd for her original idea and to Janice Lynn for helping to finalize the plan and the samples. Also, need to mention Erika Sandor, the story telling jeweler (<https://www.thestorytellingjeweller.com/>). Checkout her website, her projects using coins are called Traveler 1 and Traveler 2, for her inspiration. She is also a member of the BeadSmith Inspiration Squad, (<http://www.beadsmith.com/>).

When you have completed the challenge, post a picture of your finished piece on the DBS Facebook page no later than Monday, August 31, 2020. The names of all those who completed the challenge and posted a picture will be placed in a hat and a winner will be drawn and will receive a check in the mail for \$10.00. No voting, just complete the challenge and post a picture. That's it! The drawing will be held during our regular monthly meeting on September 5, 2020 by Zoom meeting or otherwise. So here it is:

Beaded Coin Challenge

Take a coin, any coin, can be an international coin, a special commemorative coin, a good luck coin, or even something like the smashed pennies that we used to get at the state fairs years ago (not sure if they still do that). Take this special coin and bezel it (use any beads, Delicas, seed beads, crystals, gem stones, the choice is yours) into a wearable piece of jewelry (bracelet, necklace, earrings (maybe you have 2 coins), you choose. You can use any method of beading (bead embroidery, peyote, brick stitch, RAW, CRAW, PRAW herringbone, etc., you decide. When you have completed the project please post a picture on the DBS Facebook page no later than Monday, August 31, 2020 along with a description of what your coin represents, where it came from and why it is special to you. That's it! That's all you have to do to be entered in the drawing.




- There will be no **State Fair of Texas** this year. BUT
