We also had a number of suggestions for projects that we would work as a group. These are pictured beginning on page 6 and are projects that can't be done with just one session, so we'll select a project or two to aim to begin. After selecting some projects, we'll contact the designers to see if we can negotiate a group purchase price and decide when would be best to work on these projects.

This month, Cindy Vaughn has designed some pen covers. When this was first discussed, the goal was to create a design that includes the Dallas skyline, as seen in our logo. But with the limited number of beads for a pen wrap, it just wasn't feasible. So... Cindy created a simple design with our name, but that just didn't seem to be good enough for her, so she came up with a "pretty", more stylized version with some flowers on a vine roving around through our name. Regardless of which you choose, when people see you writing with that pen, they'll start asking questions!

Lastly, we know that there was some holdup in getting going, so far as membership is concerned, but we've got options now. So if you haven't renewed your membership, it's time. A separate membership file is being loaded up to both our website and our Facebook page. Starting peyote


• Reading and working from a peyote chart

• G2 Pen


• Delicas – 3 colors, charted as db791 (red), db200 (white), and db10 (black)



 - Main lettering db793 1 gram
 - Secondary lettering db1753 ½ gram
 - Vines − db169 − ½ gram
 - Flowers db214 ¼ gram
 - Flower centers db2101 7 beads


