

What's Going On in DBS

There are a number of things that I need to update you on...

But... this now leaves one of our Advisor positions vacant. Won't you consider taking on this role for the remainder of the year? Our advisors is to participate in Board meetings and offer their input and their most active role is to be responsible for coordinating the holiday party, which, sadly, doesn't look like we'll be having in person this year unless an alternate location can be suggested. Any ideas?

This month, continuing the celebration of International Beading Week (IBW - who says it has to be limited to just one week, huh?), we, as a group decided to work Erin Simonetti's Poppy Haze Pendant, offered among the many designs available to celebrate IBW. While we are free, as individuals, to download the pattern and follow the instructions, and even gather together and work it simultaneously, we are not authorized to "teach" the project. This is a project worked on a loom. As someone who less than a year ago successfully followed Erin's instructions and referenced blog post, I was able to complete the loomed beading necessary for my project kit, so I feel confident that we, too, can do this.

To get the pattern for the Poppy Haze Pendant, go to

https://www.nationalbeadingweek.co.uk/Downloads.php and scroll down (3rd on right side) until the bright reds of the poppy catch your eye! Click on the project name to be taken to the instructions and download them. The second paragraph on page 2 of the instructions refers the user to a blog entry on her "Waning Warps Process", which I'm now having trouble finding, but there is a host of other information available on her blog at <u>Beads Beading Beaded, with Erin</u> <u>Simonetti</u>.

Additionally, in July Erin was the guest designer on the Seed Beads and More Facebook group, leading people through a loomed bead piece of a mermaid and, in addition to that pattern, Erin posted a number of incredibly helpful videos. What is lucky for us is that while one month's special offerings are usually taken down at the beginning of the next month, Erin realized that many people were doing IBW projects and so has committed to leaving her videos up until August 10. If you have a Facebook account and ARE NOT a member of the "Seed Beads and More" group, I STRONGLY encourage you to go sign up for that group. You may hate me

because of all the pretties you'll see and want to do, but this group is a **GREAT** resource! Once on the group's homepage, do a search for *#mermaidloomweaving*. There is an entry there by Anita Adamson dated July 1 with a picture that says "July Links". Expand the entry and take a look at the videos. I found a tip in the **Week 2 Part 1 video – Waning and Much More** that I hadn't caught on to before! PLEASE do this! Especially watch the video on waning because once you've learned this method, you may find a newfound love for working on a loom! And if you'd like to tackle the mermaid next, make sure to capture all of the pattern documents before they're gone on August 10!

Then join me as we work on our Poppy Pendants together, cheering each other on! I think we'll understand why some in our group are so taken to working on a loom!


