

This month, we will be following a YouTube video by Jill Wiseman on Flat Spiral Stitch, which can be used to create a bracelet and/or necklace. Why not make a matching set?

The video can be found at (290) Stitches: Flat Spiral Stitch - YouTube. Janice Lynn has provided photos of possible bead combinations (see below) and also located a second, relative video at <u>Flat Spiral Rope Seed Bead Technique Video (artbeads.com)</u>.

November is our Member Appreciation event and we are having Amy Loh-Kupser of i-bead.com teach her "Sea Treasures" bracelet. For anyone wanting to buy a kit, Amy has provided a link to a special page for us to order bead kits only that has been sent to members in email. If you'd like to purchase a bead kit from Amy, the price will be \$18. Orders are due by October 1 in order to get them back in time, so if you haven't ordered yours, NOW is the time! DBS is paying her teaching fee as well as for the instructions, so even those providing their own beads will be able to get them. If you'd like to provide your own beads, you will need:

- 4mm Fire Polish Crystals (75)
- 4mm Glass Pearls (125)
- Size 11/0 Seed Beads (5 grams)
- Clasp (snap or magnetic)
- ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES NEEDED BY ALL TAKING THE CLASS:
 - o Size 10 or 12 Beading Needle
 - o 6 lb Fireline or equivalent
 - Beading Mat, Scissors, Light, and other normal supplies

Flat Spiral Bracelet photos and quantities provided by Janice Lynn

To be prepared, you will need (quantities are based on what pieces you're making; the counts provided will make 6" of beadwork for a bracelet, allowing 1" for a clasp):

- Central bead she uses 4 or 6mm fire polish (25-6mm beads)
- Edge Accent beads 3mm or 4mm fire polish corresponding to central bead size (48-4mm beads)
- Seed beads #15 or #11 depending on size of central bead
- Clasp
- Thread (Fireline is suggested for crystals)
- Needles, lights, beading mat, scissors, and other normal supplies


BEADWORKERS GUILD

Are you looking for another online beading community to participate in? Remember International Beading Week in July? This event is hosted each year by the Beadworkers Guild in the UK and they have thriving online events as well as an incredible "Journal" published quarterly with a number of designs to be beaded. To try them out, there are two events they host that non-members can participate in: "Meet, Mingle, & Make" sessions, which each focus on a theme (October is on bezelling) and monthly "Drop In" sessions for open beading. Because a booklet featuring the theme of the Meet, Mingle, & Make sessions is provided, there is a £10 fee for these. Recognizing that they have members all over the world, each of these sessions has multiple timeframes available. I participated in a Drop In session in September and it was so much fun! In addition to people from the UK, there were multiple people from the U.S. (Las Vegas, Ohio, New Jersey, and me!), one from Switzerland, and one from South Africa.
